**BOOKS & REQUISITES** - Books and requisite fees for this year are \$140.00 per student. If payment is received in Term 1 the cost will be \$130.00. Payment may be made by cash, cheque card or direct credit.

**CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSIONS FUND (CSEF)** – Families eligible for this payment should call into the Office and complete an application form. If you applied for the CSEF at our school in 2018 you do not need to reapply for 2019. A new form will need to be completed only if you have a child starting school for the first time, if your child has changed school or if your family circumstances have changed. To be eligible you need to have a valid (on either the 1<sup>st</sup> day of term 1 or 2) means-tested concession card or be a temporary foster parent. CSEF payment of \$125.00 per year, can be used towards the cost of school trips, camps and sporting activities.
